What does he do?

The machinist manufactures and modifies parts with precise dimensions using conventional and CNC machine tools. He leads a variety of machine tools to manufacture parts and performs manual machining tasks. He plans, organizes, produces and ensures quality control of all machined parts.

Examples: machinery, engines, turbines, gears and much more.

This job is for you if ...

- you have a great sense of responsibility and a spirit of analysis
- → you are methodical and have an eye for detail
- you have good spatial perception and manual dexterity

Prerequisites

→ hold a high school diploma (DES)

or

must be at least 16 years old and have successfully completed Secondary 4 in French, in English and in Mathematics or have a recognized equivalent learning

Workplaces potential

- → machine shops
- → manufacturers of aircraft, engines, landing gear and flight simulators
- metalworking industry, avionics, electrical, chemical, medical, petrochemical etc.
